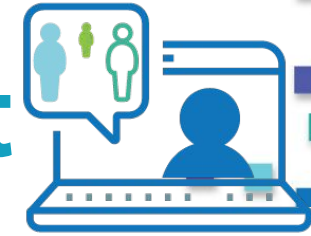

Telehealth & Teletherapy Project



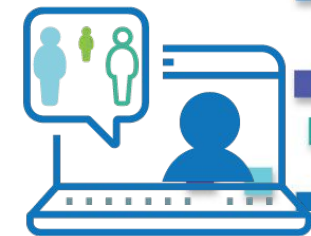
The Patterson Foundation – Digital Access for All Initiative has embarked on a research project to study the benefits of this service and we begin with collecting data.
