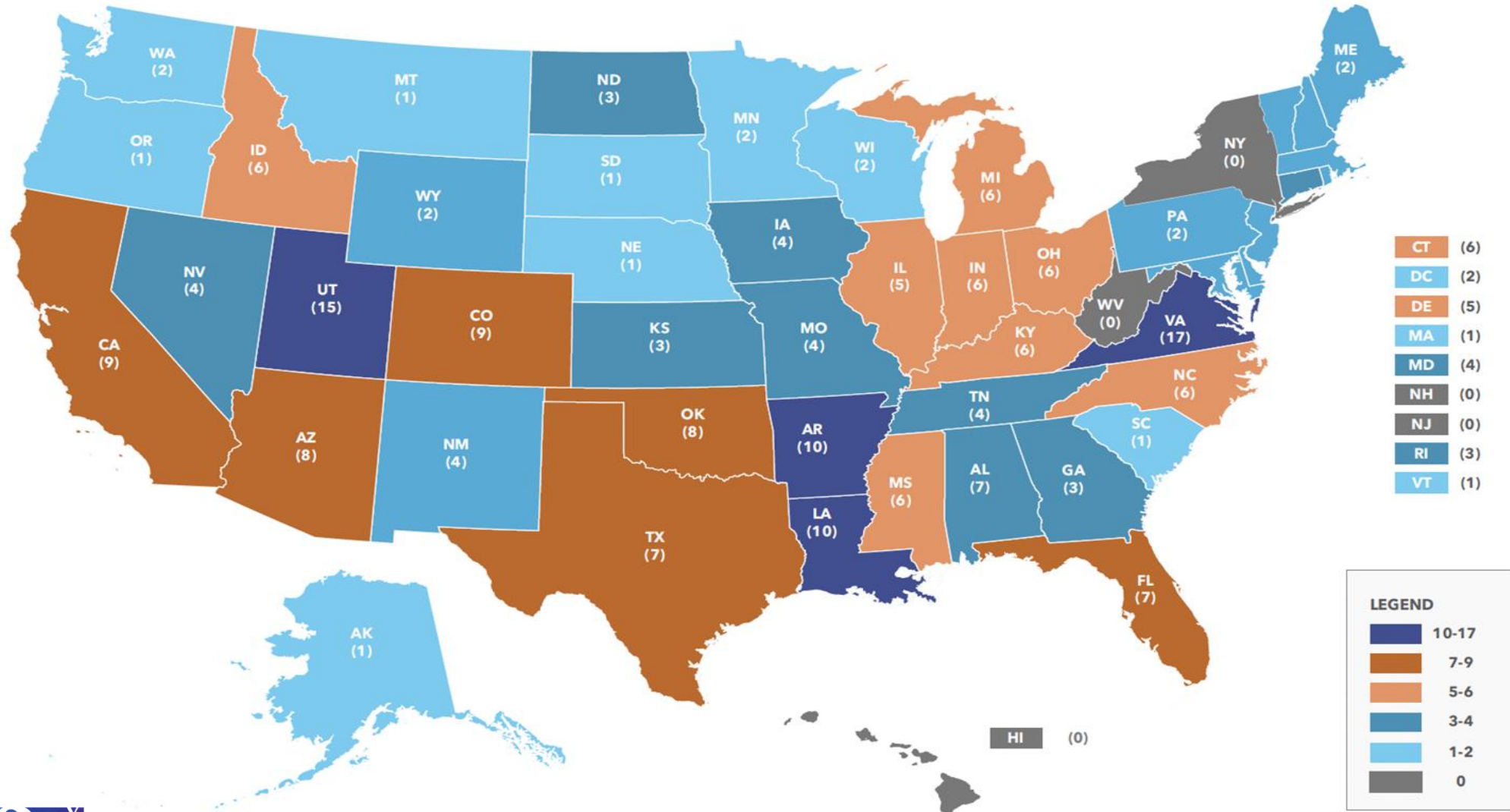

Purpose of our Project

- To create an unbiased analysis of the reading legislation across states
- To engage educators and scholars in support of reading reform (e.g. civic engagement vs. top-down mandates)
- To support an accurate framing of reading reform

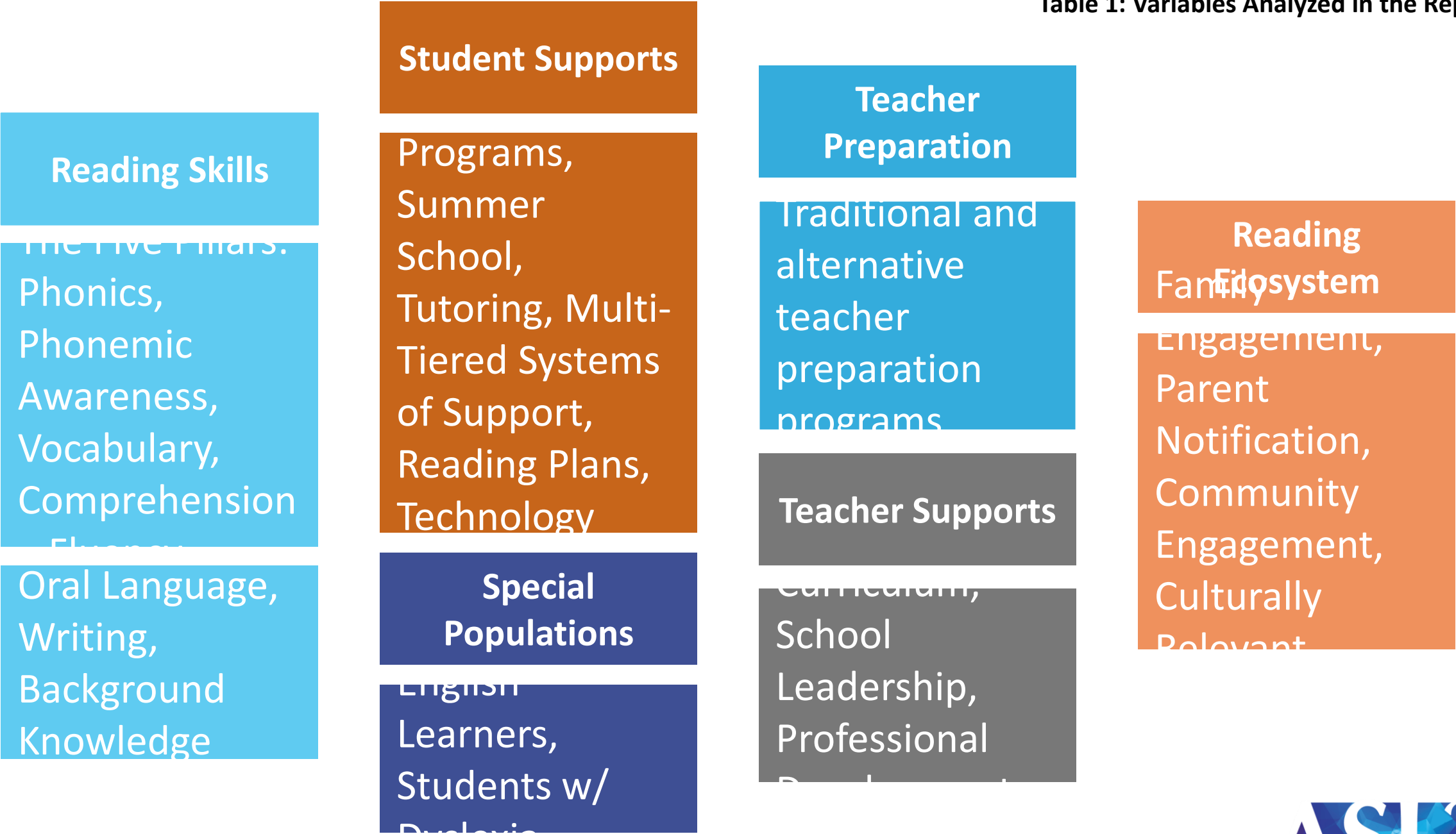
Number of State Literacy Laws Enacted Between 2019 and 2022.



Methodology

- 223 bills from 46 states during 2019 - 2022.
- Content-analyzed 40 variables (based on consensus reports and extant research literature)
- Coded (variable=0; 1; or 2) to reflect what was either absent; mentioned; or detailed in the legislation
- Inter-rater reliability=.75 and above
