



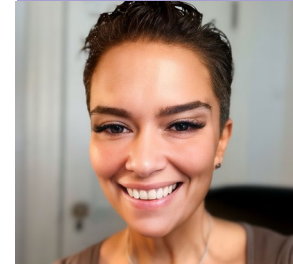

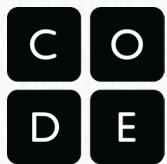

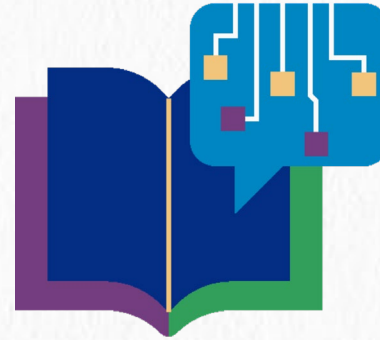

Using AI as a tool for teacher support, student learning, or school management and operations.

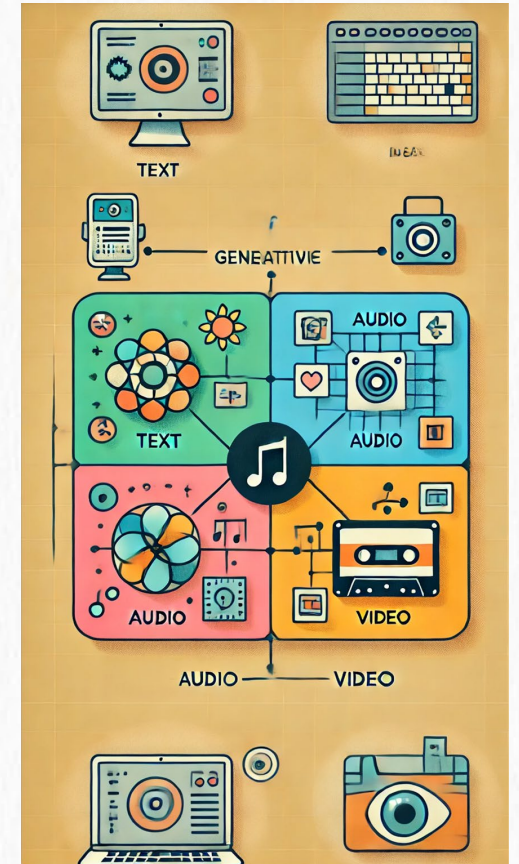
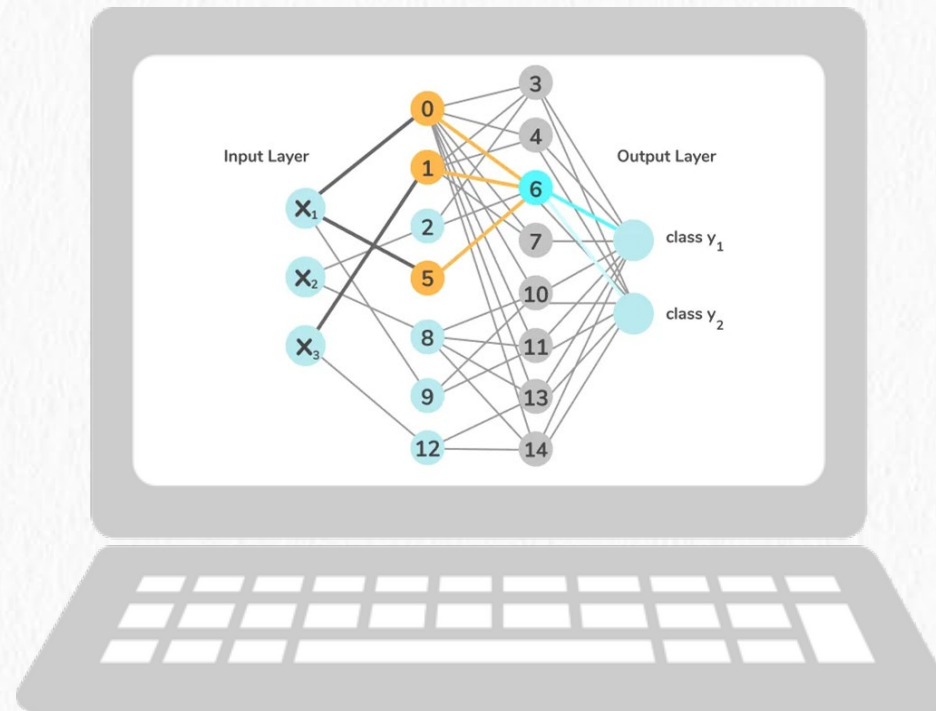


Teaching About AI
