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



SY 23-24 Partner

PLI includes 30,000 students across eight site partners over four post-pandemic years (SY22-SY25) and experimentally estimates the effects of over 25 program types.

**The key question is not just whether tutoring works on average, but which models work best for which students.**


# Overview of NJTC Tutor Apprenticeship Program (TAP)




