


Goals of Parents as Teachers

Parents as Teachers: USA Footprint




188,253 families





The Challenge of Scaling

Of the 18.0 million families who could benefit—



51% of families met one or more targeting criteria

21% of families met two or more targeting criteria


Other Challenges/Gaps

To improve the **relevance**, **quality**, and **access** to services for families and support/resources for practitioners.










Focused Study: One Component

30.4% of children between 9 and 35 months were reported by their parent or guardian to have received a completed developmental screening.

 Access and intentional Family Engagement




Human-Centered Design

Proposed solution:

Leverage IVC to increase access to screening and **identify critical elements** of the screening experience that lead to increased family engagement


- Users – home visitors and parents
- Parent interviews
- Home visitor surveys and videos
- Expert advisory group







Home Visitor Surveys and Videos



- Identified 3 phases of the screening experience
- Recognized fears and areas of low confidence
- Identified essential skills and behaviors
- Clarified coaching process


Virtual Screening Implementation




- Virtual Screening and Assessment Training
- Application for on-ground screening and assessment
- Implementation guidance, resources, and curriculum
- Other tech options

Limitations

- Won't be a fit for everyone, or solve all access issues
- Connectivity issues in some communities
- Social norm just emerging
- Workforce development needed



Cross Sector Applications



- Workforce development
- Tech-assisted service delivery practices (i.e. screening)
- Family engagement strategy




Imagine how virtual service delivery practices could be infused into your program and support family engagement.
